SHARED LABORATORY FACILITIES

Located within a selection of our Innovation buildings, The Oxford Science Park offers access to high quality shared laboratory facilities for a fixed monthly fee. These spaces provide a unique environment to connect and work alongside other companies within our community. The laboratories are fully managed by the Park's Laboratory and Facilities team who operate a fair usage policy to ensure all businesses have equal access to these exceptional facilities.

- Freezers (-20°C, -80°C & -150°C)
- Autoclaves
- Glass washers
- Ice machine
- Dry / Warming cabinet
- Centrifuge with various rotors
- Hotplate Stirrers
- Analytical balances

- Ducted and recirculating fume hoods
- RO, DI & purified water
- Workshop with soldering station and LEV, pillar drill, milling machine and assorted tools.
- Essential services generator support
- Dedicated support from The Oxford Science Park facilities team
